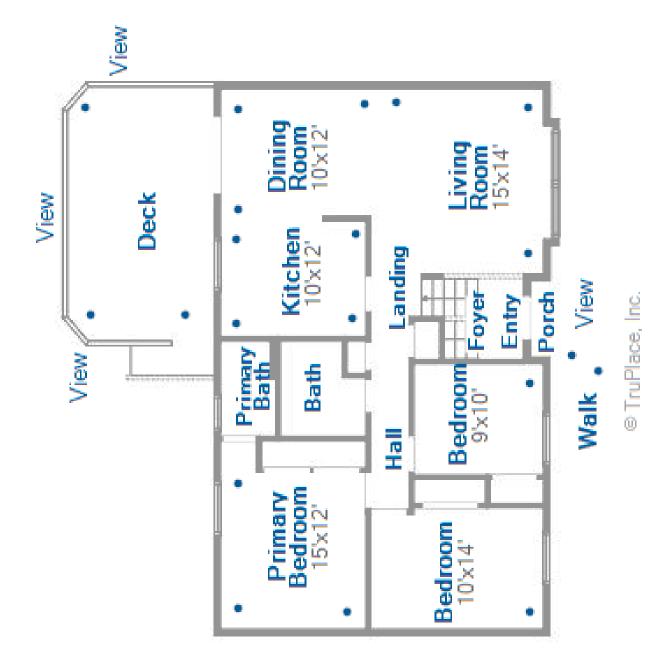

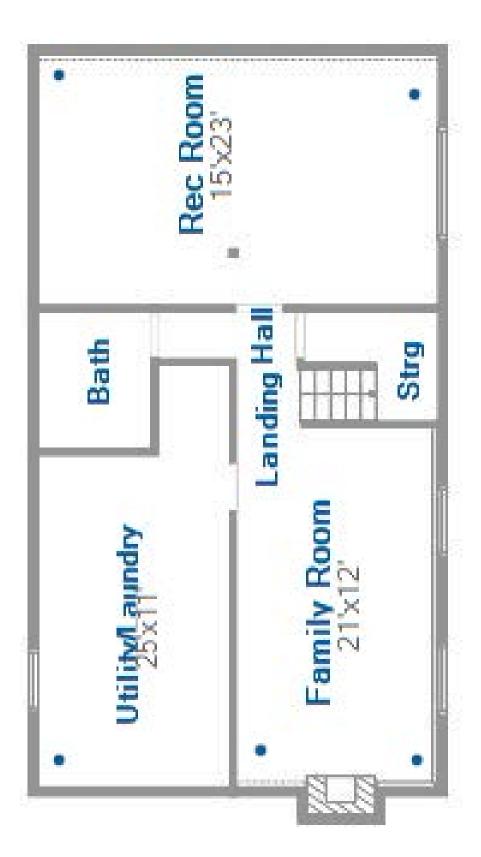


## 11528 Dragonfire Way FLOOR PLAN: MAIN LEVEL

- A sheriff's sale, tax sale, or sale by foreclosure, partition, or by court appointed trustee;
- A transfer by a fiduciary in the course of the administration of a decedent's estate, guardianship, conservatorship, or trust;
- A transfer of single family residential real property to be converted by the buyer into use other than residential use or to be demolished; or
- 7. A sale of unimproved real property.

Dear Mr. Naghibi,

Per your request, we visited the existing basement plus one floor single family house located at 11528 Dragonfire Way in Germantown, Maryland on May 28, 2025. The purpose of our visit was to evaluate the structural adequacy of the existing rear foundation wall that partially allowed water infiltration. Our visual, non- destructive observations were limited to the exposed areas. The water infiltration seems to have occurred in the vicinity of the rear deck ledger area. We understand that the water infiltration was discovered on May 11, 2025 and that the temporary waterproofing was provided on May 12, 2025. Please find below pictures of the existing house and the affected areas. Also, please find attached the proposed structural repair plans and temporary shoring.

We noticed that the existing foundation wall is an English basement made out of concrete at its lower part, and 2x4@16" on center studs extending from the top of the concrete wall to the wall top plates above. The 2x4 studs were exposed and we could observe that the damage occurred in the area clouded on drawing 2/S-110 attached. We also noticed that the existing wall top plates and rim board (in the clouded area) were damaged due to the water infiltration. It also appears that the upper floor plywood located in the vicinity of this area was affected by the water infiltration. At the time of our visit, it was raining and no water was infiltrating in the house.

We recommend that the damaged studs, wall top plates, rim board and plywood be replaced with new ones. We also recommend that the affected floor joists be sistered in kind. The exterior wall siding will also need to be removed and reinstalled after the work is completed. Prior to commencing work, temporary shoring should be installed per the attached sheets S-110 and S-120. We also recommend that approximately 3 feet of the deck be removed and reframed to facilitate the work. A company specialized in waterproofing should be hired to ensure the water

tightness of the new structure, once the framing work is completed.

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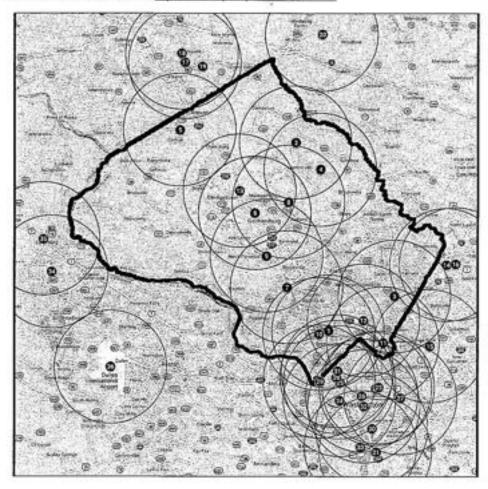

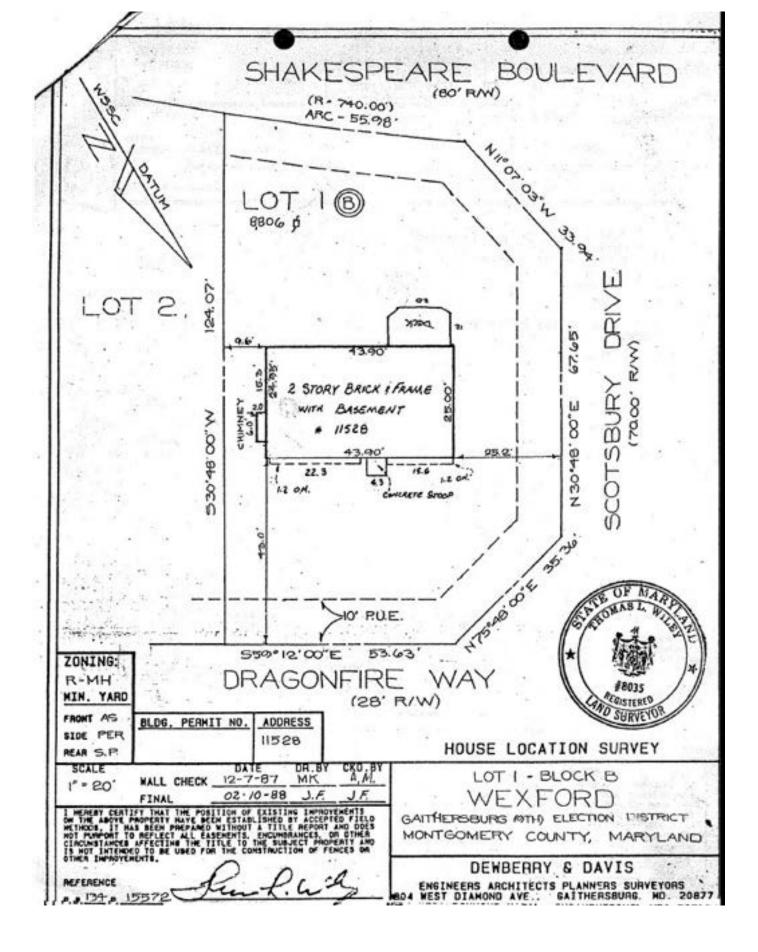

# Consent for Dual Agency

(In this form, the word "seller" includes "landlord"; "buyer" includes "tenant"; and "purchase" or "sale" includes "lease")

## When Dual Agency May Occur

The possibility of Dual Agency arises when:

- The buyer is interested in a property listed by a real estate broker; and
- The seller's agent and the buyer's agent are affiliated with the same real estate broker.

## Important Considerations Before Making a Decision About Dual Agency

A broker or the broker's designee, acting as a dual agent does not exclusively represent either the seller or buyer; there may be a conflict of interest because the interests of the seller and buyer may be different or adverse. As a dual agent, the real estate broker does not owe undivided loyalty to either the seller or buyer.

Before the buyer and seller can proceed to be represented by a broker acting as a dual agent, they must both sign Consent for Dual Agency. If the <u>buyer</u> has previously signed this Consent for Dual Agency, the buyer must affirm the buyer's consent for the purchase of a particular property before an offer to purchase is presented to the seller. If the <u>seller</u> has previously signed Consent for Dual Agency, the seller must affirm the seller's consent for the sale of the property to a particular buyer before accepting an offer to purchase the property. The affirmation is contained on Page 2 of this form.

## Your Choices Concerning Dual Agency

In a possible dual agency situation, the buyer and seller have the following options:

- 1. Consent in writing to dual agency. If all parties consent in writing, the real estate broker or the broker's designee (the "dual agent") shall assign one real estate agent affiliated with the broker to represent the seller (the seller's "intra-company agent") and another agent affiliated with the broker to represent the buyer (the buyer's "intra-company agent"). Intra-company agents are required to provide the same services to their clients that agents provide in transactions not involving dual agency, including advising their clients as to price and negotiation strategy.
- 2. Refuse to consent to dual agency. If either party refuses to consent in writing to dual agency, the real estate broker must terminate the brokerage relationship for that particular property with the buyer, the seller, or both. If the seller terminates the brokerage agreement, the seller must then either represent him or herself or arrange to be represented by another real estate company. If the buyer terminates the brokerage agreement the buyer may choose not to be represented but simply receive assistance from the seller's agent, from another agent in that company, or from a subagent from another company. Alternatively, the buyer may choose to enter into a written brokerage agreement with a different company.

Duties of a Dual Agent and Intra-Company Agent

Like other agents, unless the client gives consent to disclose the information, dual agents and intra-company agents must keep confidential information about a client's bargaining position or motivations. For example, without written consent of the client, a dual agent or intra-company agent may not disclose to the other party, or the other party's agent:

- Anything the client asks to be kept confidential; \*
- That the seller would accept a lower price or other terms;
- That the buyer would accept a higher price or other terms;
- 4) The reasons why a party wants to sell or buy, or that a party needs to sell or buy quickly; or
- Anything that relates to the negotiating strategy of a party.
- \* Dual agents and intra-company agents must disclose material facts about a property to all parties.

How Dual Agents Are Paid

Consent for Dual Agency

Only the broker receives compensation on the sale of a property listed by that broker.

If a financial bonus is offered to an agent who sells property that is listed with his/her broker, this fact must be disclosed in writing to both the buyer and seller.
